Remember keep an eye out for the Easter Bunny, he might just be hiding some eggs for you to find!


Partnership Pick Up

Medication Forms

Rainbow Pizza Recipe

Ingredients

2 pizza bases
6 tbsp passata
400g mixed red and yellow tomatoes
75g sprouting broccoli thinly sliced
8 green olives, pitted and halved (optional)
150g mozzarella cheese
2 tbsp pesto
handful of basil to serve

Method

1. Heat the oven to 180C/160C fan gas 4. Put each pizza base on a baking sheet and spread each with half of the passata. Arrange the tomatoes on the top in rings or wedges of colour and add the broccoli and the olives, if using. Squish the mozzarella cheese a little before dotting it over the pizzas, then drizzle 1 tbsp pesto over each.
2. Bake for 15-20 mins or until the top is bubbling and just starting to brown a little. Scatter over the basil leaves before serving.
