The cost for this term is £10.00

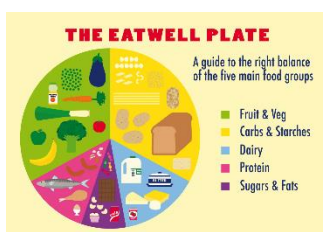
